New Business:

1. Holy Name-Site Plan Review

Owner: Diocese of Gary 11301 93rd Ave. St. John, Indiana

Petitioner: Wayne Stoll, 13237 Calumet Ave., Cedar Lake, IN 46303

Vicinity: 11000 W. 133rd Ave., Cedar Lake, IN 46303 Request: Petitioner is requesting a Site plan review.

- (1) <u>Petitioner's Comments:</u> Kenneth Gembala of Plumb, Tuckett and Associates reviewed the site plan for improvements to several parking areas at Holy Name Church. The improvements will provide upgrades to all driveways. Details regarding the drainage and rainwater runoff improvements that will divert water into the Town's improved drainage system were areas of concern. Timing and deadlines as well as cost concerns were also discussed.
- (2) <u>Town Engineer's Comments:</u> Don Oliphant of Christopher B. Burke Engineering stated that the site qualifies as hardship and that they have asked them to maximize pipe sizes as much as possible. He also stated that the site basically is already improved and upon completion this would be very beneficial to the town. In summary a change order will be issued, and the cost will be billed back to the Diocese of Gary.

Ian suggested a motion to approve the site plan as presented, to waive the remaining technical requirements, to ensure that the catch basins in existing gravel are covered until such time as they are paved with a coat of asphalt, to allow for a connection to the municipal detention facility and require that all paving on the site is completed by November 30, 2016.

Tim Kubiak asked for it to be contingent on being reviewed by legal counsel, since they were not present at this meeting. Ian then stated that it had already been discussed, reviewed and all good.

Motion made by Patsy Casassa and seconded by Jim Hunley to approve the site plan as presented, to waive the remaining technical requirements, to ensure that the catch basins in existing gravel are covered until such time as they are paved with a coat of asphalt, to allow for a connection to the municipal detention facility and require that all paving on the site is completed by November 30, 2016.
