A. Economic Development Funding

Town Administrator Murr spoke regarding the newly created Economic Development Committee. The group is looking to travel to Lake Geneva for economic development research. Approximate cost is around \$3,000. They are asking for the Commission to fund the trip. President Vis explained that the Town Council recently created an Economic Development Committee comprised of three Council members, two RDC members, as well as the Town Administrator. The goal is to develop a relationship with towns similar to ours, like Lake Geneva, to learn from them and glean ideas to boost economic development. Town Council President Randy Niemeyer shared his vision for the new Committee. He's been in contact with Andy Dammeir, Economic Development Director for Lake Geneva, opening the lines of communication and beginning a working relationship. The Commission had a lengthy discussion with Mr. Niemeyer regarding future plans and the requested funds.
