

**Storm Water Board
Public Meeting
June 12, 2012**

The Storm Water Board for the Town of Cedar Lake held its work session on June 12, 2012. The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:03 p.m. Members present were: Glenn Sechen, Mike DeFrancesco, Vice Chairman, and Norm Stick, Chairman. James Cornett of Public Works and Jenn Montgomery, Recording Secretary, were also present.

- I. **Minutes:** Minutes from the May 22, 2012 public meeting will be voted on at the next public meeting on June 26, 2012.

- II. **Public Comment: Christina Schreiber**, who owns the business at 10733 W 133rd Avenue, was present tonight to discuss if there are any possible solutions to the drainage concerns at the stated address. Norm Stick stated that the building is lower than the road, with the driveway sloping down toward the building. Jim Cornett stated he is trying to get a crew out there to open up a swale. Unfortunately, there is not much the Board can do because most of the issues are located on private property. The Board suggested installing a drain across the front of the driveway to try to deter the water from going down to the building. It was also suggested that a curb be installed around the front of the building in order to detour the water flow to the grass. Discussion occurred regarding other possible solutions, including televising lines and inspecting the basins to see if they are in working order. The Board stated they will continue to look into this item.

 - A. Wicker Meadows Subdivision; drainage concerns. Discussion occurred regarding the flooding issues in the area. It appears as if the water flow is coming from the south. There is a twelve (12) inch outflow from the detention pond, but that the pond has never overflowed. Mike DeFrancesco asked who owns the detention pond. Discussion occurred regarding whether or not the Town has access to the pond or who is responsible for the pond. The field to the west of the detention pond is not within the Town limits. As of now, it doesn't seem that the Town is allowed to access the detention pond. The Board agreed that more information is needed.
