Storm Water Board Public Meeting September 24, 2013

The Storm Water Board for the Town of Cedar Lake held its regular Public meeting on September 24, 2013. The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:00 p.m. Members present were: Joe Trtan and Norman Stick. Staff members present were: Jim Cornett of Public Works, Robert Carnahan; Town Council, and Jessica Chick; Recording Secretary.

Public Comment: Don Sizemore, 7408 W. 129th Ave., Cedar Lake, IN 46303. He is present to reclaim a solution to the water problem he currently has to a problem going down the hill into his property. When there is heavy rainfall, the water runs down the hill so fiercely into his neighbor's property and into the side of his house. The water then proceeds into his driveway. There was a hole filled by the Town by his driveway that was filled with gravel that has washed away from the rain. Another problem is when the water freezes down the hill in the winter, it is a dangerous predicament. The problem is depreciating that value of his home. He had asked for something to be done about these problem years ago, the Town said they would dig a trench and put a crate in to help with the current problem. It had been suggested by the Town to dig up half of his driveway but his goal is to widen his driveway for safety reasons. The suggestion per Storm Water Board member Norman Stick is to install culverts and also a curb to help rectify the problem. If culverts are installed underneath the driveways it would help to alleviate some of the water as well as a curb to help keep the bulk of the water out. The installation of curbs will have to go through the Town Council. The Town does not cut out or replace concrete, that would be liable upon the owner, but we will install the culvert. There is however a gas line parallel to the owner's driveway. An engineer study would also most likely have to be done on the property in order to see where the water would end up if the culvert and curb are installed. A catch basin is also suggested to be placed on the property. The Town engineer will be contacted in order to look at the problem at hand.

IV. Work Session Items:

A. Parrish Fields, drainage project; piping requirements; cost and project update. Due to the fact that it was unknown that when it is within ten (10) feet of a waterline that you have to use a specific piping, we are in the process of pricing the correct materials needed. A motion had previously been made approving the HDPE piping for this project; the piping however did not meet the State and Federal guideline. Resulting in the resending of the previously made motion for this project to approve the new piping materials as well as increasing the budget from \$15,000 to \$20,000. Pricing had been acquired regarding the new piping, C900, from HD Supply at \$17,340. The overall piping needed is around 12,000 feet. The budget for this project is \$20,000. If this type of pipe is not used, a catch basin can be installed as well as a clean out, than transition to the other pipe.
