CALL TO ORDER:

MINUTES:

OLD BUSINESS:

A. Drainage issues at 9080 W 129th **PI:** Don stated there is no update on this project. The middle parcel has to be skipped. Keep this on Old Business.

UPDATE ITEMS:

- **A. Chuck Becker-7513 W 136th Ave:** Don stated that there is nothing new for this project that wasn't stated at the last meeting. This project is pending funding and granting of easements. We will keep on Update Items. Chris Salatas recommended not taking action to move forward until funding is known.
- **B. Schubert/Dodge Street:** Don updated the board that this project is on the back burner for now.

We are unable to get a camera down and needs more investigation.

C. Woods of Cedar Creek: Margaret stated that she has been updating a spreadsheet with addresses and phone numbers for involved parties, but it is her understanding that this project will not

proceed until funding is established.

D. 9402 W 141st PI: This resident came to the last meeting to bring attention to his culvert which is not draining. This parcel is just south of 141st ave at Cottage Grove where there is standing water. Don stated it seems someone filled in the ditch in the last couple of years and buried the pipes. Pipe

locations and possible solutions were discussed between Eric and Don. Not a pressing item but does

need to be fixed. Ryan Lisek requested to look at the property and keep on Update Items.

PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS:

Jeff Bunge – 14619 Bell Place: No change in status for this project. He should call for locates. A.

146th & Reeder Road: Eric stated that half of this ditch has been done and discussed the В.

upcoming plans and schedule for this project. Keep on Public Works Projects. Plans are to have it done

before next month.

NEW BUSINESS:

Bryan Street, South Shore: Eric stated that NIPSCO crushed a pipe and left it. We intend to fix

it but are looking for compensation for materials. Add to Public Works Projects for next agenda.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bryan Tiemens, 6814 W 142nd Pl, Woods of Cedar Creek – Mr. Tiemens requested to know what lots

require easement rights so they can lobby those people.

Juliann Gibbons, 6425 W 145th St - Ms. Gibbons stated that the road in front of the house is splitting and water builds up and sits for days. The culvert across the street is small and clogged. She has water issues in her backyard – has a river that runs through her backyard including broken pipes, sinkholes and

bubbling water. She purchased the property in November and was not notified by sellers of any water

issues. She also has issues with 14436 Colfax and drainage to her property. Don offered to go to the

property to look at the situation. He said that it sounds like a sewer tap issue.
