1. Shades/Oaks Bid Award

lan Nicolini stated that the bid summary report for the Shades/Oaks Roadway and Drainage Improvements was distributed. Four (4) bids were received for this project. The lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder is Grimmer Construction with a bid of \$1,338,459.70 which is about \$90,000.00 lower than the engineer's estimate for the project and about \$300,000.00 less than the funds that are in the bond for construction. It is the recommendation to award the bid to Grimmer Construction and direct staff to prepare the additional roadway and drainage work that the additional funds could be used for. David Austgen noted that the contracts are being circulated and all forms are in order. Motion by Jerry Smith and seconded by Randy Niemeyer to award the bid to Grimmer Construction in the amount of \$1,338,459.70 and have the Town Administrator to put the documentation together for the additional drainage and roadwork.

2. Cedar Point Park Bid Award

lan Nicolini stated that five (5) bids were received for the Cedar Point Park Subdivision Roadway and Drainage Improvements project. The lowest, responsive and responsible bidder is Grimmer Construction with a base bid including the alternate bid of \$1,306,960.70. That reflects the inclusion of Alternate 1 which is the back up power for the storm sewer lift station. This project will likely require another bid for the additional improvements to spend the construction funds. Motion by Jerry Smith and seconded by John Foreman to approve the award of the contract to bid to Grimmer Construction and to authorize the Town Administrator to go ahead with the bidding of the additional work.
