133rd Ave Road Construction Update

The INDOT 133rd Ave Roadway Reconstruction Project on the west side of Town is winding down for the winter. In an attempt to make the road as safe as possible for the traveling public and emergency vehicles during the winter months, the center lane of traffic will remain closed but has been wedged in areas where there are significant grade changes between existing and proposed roadway elevations. Please continue to use the temporary outer lanes for travel and please obey all construction signage including the 20 mph speed zones. The center lane should only be used in case of emergencies or to yield the way for emergency vehicles. Roadway construction will continue again in the spring with a proposed completion date of June 2015, weather permitting. We appreciate your patience during the construction process and are all looking forward to completing the final phase of our Town's main entrance from the west.

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Dog Tag Renewal

Dog owners are required to renew their licenses annually at the Clerk-Treasurer's Office located at 7408 Constitution Avenue during business hours, Monday – Friday 8AM-5PM. During the months of January through March 31st, the cost is \$10 per dog with a maximum of three dogs permitted at each residence. After March 31st, the cost will be \$15 per dog. A valid rabies certification is required in order to renew the license. It is the responsibility of the dog owner to ensure that the rabies shots are renewed per veterinarian's certificate. For those who are unable to come to the Town Hall to renew the dog license, we will accept a copy of the valid rabies certificate, and payment by check, through the mail or the drop box at our parking lot. Upon receipt of your information and payment, we will process your license and mail it to you. For more information, please call our office at (219) 374-7000.

Adopt a Fire Hydrant

The Cedar Lake Fire Department is asking for your help during the winter months by keeping the snow around the fire hydrant clear near your house. It would be very helpful if you adopted the hydrant as a very important part of your property. During a fire every minute counts. In fact, every minute a fire doubles in size, so the sooner we can get water on it the better. Remember, if you have a fire hydrant near your house you can notify your insurance company and may receive a lower rate. 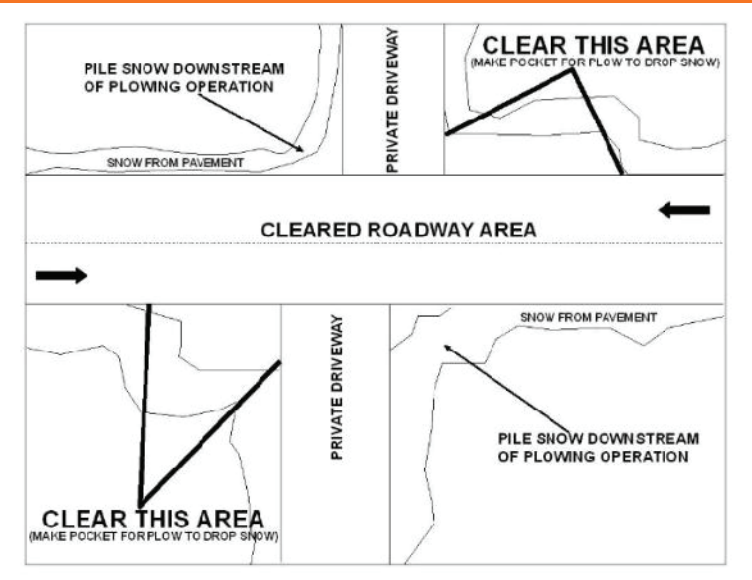
Pot Holes and Repairs

This winter season has already hit our town hard. Extreme temperatures and precipitation have given us the perfect formulation for pot-holes, and they have come through in numbers. The Public Works Department is out with multiple crews filling these holes with cold patch and the total-patcher (when applicable). The melting snow and occasional rain can mask these holes with water, so please be aware of the road and weather conditions. The pot-hole crews make frequent stops, so please pay attention to any flashing lights or crew members that may be on the road. Together we can stay safe and keep our streets maintained!



Keep Your Driveways Clear

As the winter months continue to dump snow on the Region, we have received lots of calls from residents about snow buildup on their driveways. Snow plows do a great job of keeping our roads clear but often there is residual snow pushed in front of driveway entrances. You can help prevent snow plows from blocking your driveway by clearing a portion of the road shoulder immediately adjacent to your driveway. Doing so provides an area where snow from the plow truck can be deposited before reaching your driveway. (See illustration below.)



2014 Building Department Permits

The Cedar Lake Building Department is excited to share with its residents that as of November 2014 we have estimated a total of 104 new home permits for 2014, we are still awaiting final counts for the month of December. Last year, we reported 100 new home permits which was a significant increase from 2012 and 2011, with 61 and 30 new home permits reported. In 2014, the Town of Cedar Lake had several commercial permits pulled for the new Detailed Dental Offices and Bobb Auto Group. The new Town Complex restroom facility and Centennial Clubhouse were also open for use in 2014. The Town of Cedar Lake is continually seeing growth in our community and is looking forward to another successful building year in 2015!
