Dog Tag Renewal

Dog owners are required to renew their licenses annually at the Clerk-Treasurer's Office located at 7408 Constitution Avenue during business hours, Monday- Friday 8AM-5PM. During the months of January, February, and March, the cost is \$10 per dog with a maximum of three dogs permitted at each residence. After March 31st, the cost will be \$15 per dog. A valid rabies certification is required in order to renew the license. It is the responsibility of the dog owner to ensure that the rabies shots are renewed per veterinarian's certificate. For those who are unable to come to the Cedar Lake Town Hall to renew the dog license, we will accept a copy of the valid rabies certificate, and payment by check, through the mail or drop box at our parking lot.
