On Tuesday, January 20, 2015 the Town Council formally announced the appointment of Jill M. Murr as Town Administrator. Jill Murr has worked for the Town of Cedar Lake for the last seven years, most recently holding the position as Chief Deputy Clerk since 2010. She has a diverse background in the private, non-profit and government sectors with a strong skill set in management, accounting and construction. Jill Murr will bring a unique quality to this position with her experience from the Clerk's Office managing municipal budgets, internal process and cash flow. She currently holds credentialing as a Certified Public Manager from Ball State University, Indiana Association of Municipal Clerks, Certified Municipal Officer, and in 2014 obtained her Master Municipal Clerk certification. As a wife and mother of three, her family relocated from Crete, Illinois to the Cedar Lake area in 1999. On January 6, 2015 during a Town Council Public Meeting, nominations were made to elect the new Town Council Officers and Board and Commission Members. Randy Niemeyer and Patsy Casassa were reappointed Town Council President and Vice President for another annual term. The Town Council motioned to reorganize the Police Commission from a five member commission to a three member commission and approved Commissioner Kevin Toth to serve



a new three year term. Nathan Vis, Jeff DeVries, and Eric Burnham were reappointed to the Redevelopment Commission joined by two new members, Jolie Covaciu and Doug Spencer. The Town Council reappointed Jeff Bunge to serve another four year term on the Board of Zoning Appeals. Dog Tag Renewal

Dog owners are required to renew their licenses annually at the Clerk-Treasurer's Office located at 7408 Constitution Avenue during business hours, Monday– Friday 8AM-5PM. During the months of January, February, and March, the cost is \$10 per dog with a maximum of three dogs permitted at each residence. After March 31st, the cost will be \$15 per dog. A valid rabies certification is required in order to renew the license. It is the responsibility of the dog owner to ensure that the rabies shots are renewed per veterinarian's certificate. For those who are unable to come to the Cedar Lake Town Hall to renew the dog license, we will accept a copy of the valid rabies certificate, and payment by check, through the mail or drop box at our parking lot.
