#### Cedar Lake Town Code 94.23- Removal of Ice and Snow:

"It shall be the duty of the owner or the occupant of each and every property of real estate in the town abutting upon any sidewalk to keep the sidewalk abutting his premises free and clear of snow and ice, and to remove therefrom all snow and ice accumulated thereon within a reasonable time, which will ordinarily not to exceed 12 hours after the abatement of any storm during which the snow and ice may have accumulated."
