April 22nd - Earth Day Rain Barrel Event

Did you know that lawn and garden watering make up almost 40% of water usage during the summer months? A rain barrel collects water and stores it for when you need it most! Saving water not only helps protect the environment, it saves you money and energy. Diverting water from storm drains also decreases the impact of runoff to streams. Therefore, a rain barrel is an easy way for you to have a consistent supply of clean, fresh water for outdoor use, free. The Town of Cedar Lake will work with UpCycle Products to host a rain barrel event on Earth Day, April 22nd! A link is on the Town's website: www.cedarlakein.org, which allows you to pre-order your rain barrel for spring! Prices start from \$56.50 for a 55 gallon barrel and range with the type of product. Rain barrels come in black, grey, blue, and terra cotta. Pre-ordered rain barrels will be available for pick up on Earth Day at the Cedar Lake Town Hall, 7408 Constitution Avenue. Delivery and installation is also offered through UpCycle Products.

Town-wide Cleanup!

On Saturday, April 11th at the Town Garage, 8550 Lakeshore Dr., Public Works will host a town-wide cleanup from 8:00am-2:00pm. Public Works will be accepting large items such as televisions and refrigerators, construction debris (excluding concrete, and railroad ties), and household hazardous waste. Household hazardous waste items include batteries, fluorescent tubes, oil based paint, automotive supplies, antifreeze, pesticides, and flammable liquids.

133rd Avenue Road Construction Update

Now that spring is upon us, the final stage of construction has begun on 133rd Avenue Westside. Please drive carefully through this area as workers will be out on the roads and temporary lane changes may occur. Weather permitting this project is scheduled for a substantial completion date of June 2015. Some of the new features as part of the completion include a center turn lane, improvements to the railroad crossing, addition of sidewalks with decorative street lighting, utility improvements

street lighting, utility improvements including the water main extension, new storm sewers, and a large section of replacement of sanitary sewer.
