Indiana Bicentennial 2016

In honor of Indiana's Bicentennial all 19 cities and towns in Lake County were asked to raise the 1818 United States Flag in honor of the Bicentennial. A replica of the 1818 US flag, which was raised Friday, August 5th at Town Hall will fly until December 11, 2016, when it will be 'retired' and put on display in Cedar Lake's Town Hall.

In conjunction with other activities on Saturday, September 24th at 1:00pm the Cedar Lake Museum will host Terry Lynch of HFK Presentation as the 23rd President of the United States, Benjamin Harrison of Indianapolis, bringing into focus what enabled the great state of Indiana to influence the nation. Following this presentation at 2:30pm the Dyer Wind Ensemble will perform music from their Bicentennial Concert.

In honor of Indiana's Bicentennial, the Torch Relay will be coming through Lake County. There are 30 people that have been chosen to carry this torch. Our own Town Council Member Robert Carnahan will be one of the torch bearers as it comes through Lake County, Indiana.
