# **Cedar Lake Ecosystem Restoration**

On July 14, 2016, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Chicago District, and the Town of Cedar Lake held a public meeting for the Cedar Lake Aquatic Ecosystem Restoration Project. Thank you to all of those who were able to attend and to Cedar Lake Ministries for hosting this event. USACE Colonel Christopher Drew recognized his staff in attendance and noted the purpose of the meeting was to provide the public with information about the project, as well as gather public input and comments on the recommended plan. Imad Samara, Project Manager and David Bucaro, P.E., Chief, Economic Formulation and Analysis, USACE presented the project. Public comments were made and USACE David Bucaro responded to some of the profound concerns.

On July 21, 2016, USACE and town representatives, including Town Council members Julie Rivera and John Foreman, Town Administrator Jill Murr, and Project Manager Kay Whitlock, Christopher B. Burke Engineering, met in Indianapolis with representatives of Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) and Indiana Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) to discuss the draft feasibility report.

The draft feasibility report describes the ecosystem project that could be implemented within the 781-acre glacially formed Cedar Lake, as well as along Founders Creek, a tributary to Cedar Lake. This report addresses the need to restore the ecosystem.

Features of the proposed project, the locally preferred plan, described in the draft report include restoration of aquatic plants, reestablishment of a native fish community, and rerouting of Founders Creek to its historic connection with Cedar Lake, removal of 263,000 cubic yards of sediment, chemical substrate restoration through alum dosage over 400-acres of the lake bottom, and implementation of controls.

USACE has extended the comment period and is accepting comments on the report through August 22, 2016. The report and ecosystem restoration information is available on the town's website at
