A Message From Public Works...

Public Works will again be open the third Saturday of each month for dumpster access: April 15, May 20, June 17, July 15, August 19, September 16 and finally October 21 from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm.

Visitors must sign in upon visit, presenting a Cedar Lake driver's license and or a current Cedar Lake utility bill, as the garbage dumpsters, yard waste and branch disposal are for residents only. Our metal and tire recycling is open to ALL Lake County, IN residents as is the recycling center at the entrance of the Public Works facility. The facility is equipped with a camera system so we ask that if anyone is in question whether or not something can be disposed of here, please contact us and we can either confirm items or help you find proper disposal.

Notice to Utility Customers Using Online Bank Payment Services

Avoiding Late Fees with Utility Payment Conveniences

The town is experiencing many utility customers using online banking features in order to pay bills. While this feature saves customers time and resources, please consider the timing involved in processing such payments. The banks issue a physical check and send it to us by U.S. Mail. This may take a few days before the town actually receives the payment. The Utility Billing Department collects mail every business day to ensure payments are credited to your accounts on the day it is received. However, we cannot be responsible for the actions of the banks or the postal service. If a holiday occurs within the time frame, please consider this when processing your online payment with the bank.

Utility bills are due by the tenth (10th) of the month with a ten (10) day grace period before the delinquent date occurs. After the twentieth (20th) of the month, the bill is considered past due and a penalty will be applied to the account. If this date falls on a weekend or holiday, the next business day is considered the delinquent date. Always confirm that your utility account number is accurately entered on the bank's payment site before the payment is submitted. The bank will send us this payment by mail with the account number as a reference. Having the correct account number available ensures that your payment is posted accordingly.

To avoid the possibility of delayed payment, we recommend using one of the town's features.

Sign up for auto withdrawal by submitting the completed form with a voided check. The form is available on our website or by contacting us directly. Payment will be electronically withdrawn from your account on the fifteenth (15th) of the month or next business day. This service is free of charge.

Pay online 24/7 by going to the link on our homepage at www.cedarlakein.org. Credit and debit cards are accepted, and e-checks. A convenience fee is charged and retained by our vendor for processing the payment. Your account number and a PIN, located on your monthly bill, are needed to access the information. You may also call us directly to make a credit or debit card payment.

Pay by phone 24/7 by calling toll free (855) 246-9327 and follow the automated instructions. A convenience fee is charged and retained by the vendor for processing the payment. Credit and debit cards are accepted. Make sure to have your bill available when calling. You may also call us directly to make a credit or debit card payment.

E-billing is also available to avoid any delays by the postal service. Your monthly utility bill will be emailed to you. Please call us if you are interested in signing up for this feature. There is no charge for this service.

Did you know that lawn and garden watering make up almost 40% of water usage during the summer months? A rain barrel collects water and stores it for when you need it most! Saving water not only helps protect the environment, it saves you money and energy. Diverting water from storm drains also decreases the impact of runoff to streams. Therefore, a rain barrel is an easy way for you to have a consistent supply of clean, fresh water for outdoor use, free. The Town of Cedar Lake will work with UpCycle Products to host a rain barrel event for Earth Day, April 22nd! You can order through the town's website, www.cedarlakein.org, which will allow you to pre-order your rain barrel for this spring! Prices start from \$56.50 for a 55-gallon barrel and range with the type of product. Rain barrels come in black, grey, blue, and terra cotta. Pre-ordered rain barrels will be available for pick up on Friday, April 21st from 2:00pm-5:00pm at the Cedar Lake Town Hall, 7408 Constitution Avenue. Delivery and installation is also offered through UpCycle Products.

Dog Licenses

Dog license renewal will take place from January through March 2017. The fee is \$10.00 per dog; up to three dogs allowed per residence. A valid rabies vaccination certificate is required in order to renew the license. After March, the fee will increase to \$15.00 per dog. The licenses are available at the Clerk-Treasurer's Office Monday through Friday from 8:00am-5:00pm.

All businesses and residents having an alarm system are to obtain a permit from the town. This permit can be completed at the Clerk-Treasurer's Office during business hours Monday through Friday from 8:00am-5:00 pm The fee is \$10.00 and the permit is valid for two (2) years from the date of application. Necessary information for the permit includes the name, address and phone number of three (3) contacts, and the phone number of your service provider.
