## SPRING INTO CONSTRUCTION SEASON

We are pleased to provide an update to the ongoing planning process to meet the infrastructure needs of the Town. The Cedar Lake Town Council engaged VS Engineering to prioritize the Town's road infrastructure and maintenance needs. From this data we now have the information concerning each and every road within the Town's municipal boundaries. This information has given us the ability to implement a Maintenance and Improvement Plan. The Maintenance and Improvement Plan used a PASER rating system to evaluate all the roads, labeled, and numbered them based on the necessary improvements. The scale is from 1-10, 1 requiring the most attention and 10 no maintenance required. PASER uses visual inspection to evaluate pavement surface conditions. The ratings consist of many different variables

including traffic, drainage, adequate strength, and curbs. This information will serve as a guide to help direct the Town's planning and construction of road infrastructure projects.

The Town is currently made up of over 67 miles of roads! Over the past 10 years, thanks to the residents of Cedar Lake and our hardworking staff, we have accomplished the reconstruction and/or resurfacing of over 24 miles! That is almost 40% of our Town! This has not gone without cost and many efforts from all the different working parties. It has cost roughly \$23,300,600.00 to reconstruct this amount of roads. This not only includes the physical reconstruction, but the planning that also goes into road projects. This investment is inclusive of but not limited to engineering, construction, drainage, as well as the physical

hours from our local Public Works crews. The completion of road construction projects, over the last 10 years shows that the taxpayers and their elected officials are continuing to strive to make the Town of Cedar Lake the world class hometown it has become.



The Maintenance and Improvement Plan will be made available on our website, as well as hard copies available at our Town Hall during normal business hours Monday through Friday. In the months to follow we will be providing you with information on cost analysis, current projects within the Town, and the different opportunities for funding.

Therefore, a rain barrel is an easy way for you to have a consistent supply of clean, fresh water for outdoor use, free. The Town of Cedar Lake will work with UpCycle Products to host a rain barrel event for Earth Day, April 22nd! Prices start from \$56.50 for a 55 gallon barrel and range with the type of product. Rain barrels come in black, grey, blue, and terra cotta.
