

ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS

Last month we published an article about the ongoing infrastructure needs of the Town. This map depicts the \$23 plus million investment into the reconstruction and resurfacing of over 24 miles of roadways in the Town. This investment is inclusive of but not limited to engineering, construction, drainage, as well as the physical hours from our local Public Works crews. The Town is moving forward with the 2017-2018 road project design and bid documents, etc. Active dialogue is occurring between our Town Administrator, Lake County Commissioner Jerry Tippy, and Lake County Highway personnel on the potential of a joint road construction project on Parrish Avenue from 141st to 151st. The Town is continually striving to meet the needs of our growing community.

HYDRANT FLUSHING TO BEGIN EARLY APRIL

The Water Department will be flushing fire hydrants beginning early April. "Hydrant Flushing" signs will be placed 24 hours in advance for every area being flushed. Additionally, they will have signs indicating 'hydrant flushing today' in all areas where the hydrants are being flushed that day. Hydrant flushing is necessary to test water pressure and flow from all fire hydrants, as well as removing sediment from the water mains. It is common for some areas to see discolored water during and immediately after hydrant flushing. When this happens, the best course of action would be to run the cold water tap for a few minutes until the water clears. Sometimes it may be necessary to repeat this a few times if the sediment was high in that area.
