#### Slow Down: Back to School Means Sharing the Road

The Cedar Lake Police Department will be providing additional Police Officers in those zones to ensure a safe environment for our school children.

#### Cedar Lake Police offer these safety tips:

It's that time of year again when schools across the county will soon be back in full swing. Motorists can prepare for the back-to-school driving season by following a few simple safety tips.

- Slow Down! The speed limit in school zones is reduced to 25 mph for a reason. Watch for children walking in the street, especially if there are no sidewalks in the neighborhood.
- Yield to School Busses Exercise caution when approaching a school bus or driving near bus stops. NEVER pass a school bus while its lights are flashing and children are entering or exiting the bus.
- Eliminate Distractions Be aware that children often behave unpredictably, so keep an eye out for kids darting into the street or crossing without first looking both ways for traffic.
- **Reverse Responsibly** Check for children on the sidewalk, driveway and around your vehicle before slowly backing up. If you have children, teach them to never play in, under or around vehicles – even those that are parked.
- Watch for Bicycles Children on bikes are often inexperienced, unsteady and unpredictable. Slow down and allow at least three feet of passing distance between your vehicle and the bicycle.
- Look Out for New/Inexperienced Drivers When driving (especially near high school campuses), keep in mind that a higher number of motorists you encounter may be teens hitting the road for the first time.

#### **ROAD AND STORM WATER** IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AROUND TOWN


