For those who need a more Gentle Exercise – try sitting while working out. It's easy and you still get the benefits of a work out.

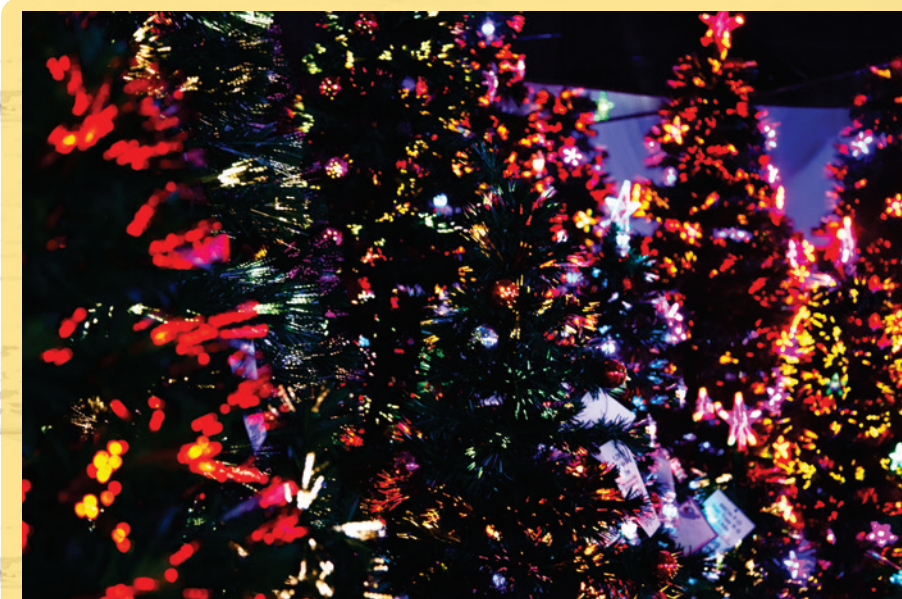
