SPRING INTO CONSTRUCTION SEASON



Spring is on its way and so are the Town's infrastructure and reconstruction improvement projects. 2018 will be a busy year as work continues on many projects and starts up on new projects.

Parrish Avenue – 141st to 151st

The Town has worked diligently to prepare for the reconstruction of Parrish Avenue – 141st to 151st Avenue. This project is expected to begin this Spring! Jill Murr, Town Administrator, worked diligently to secure grant funding for this project. The hard work paid off and the Town was awarded a \$690,000 Community Crossing Matching Grant to be utilized for this ~\$1.6M reconstruction project. The scope of work includes a full roadway reconstruction and intersection improvements.

Lincoln Plaza Entrance Improvement Project

Lincoln Plaza Entrance Improvement Project is another sign of advancement of the Town. The Redevelopment Commission is investing ~ \$500,000 into this entranceway renovation and improvement project.

Roadway Improvements

The ~\$4.2 M **High Grove Subdivision** road and infrastructure project will start back up from its winter shut down and the ~\$3.1 M **South Shore Subdivision** road and infrastructure project will get underway. NIPSCO and its subcontractors' have been busy replacing gas mains and service lines in these areas.

Lake Shore Drive/Cline Avenue Intersection Improvement/Roundabout Project

The \$2.5 M Lake Shore Drive/Cline Avenue Intersection Improvement Roundabout project received approval from INDOT and NIRPC to fund this construction project three years earlier than anticipated. Town Administrator

Jill Murr continually represented the Town, communicating with NIRPC and INDOT representatives, to advance this project into INDOT's fiscal year 2019 instead of 2022. Just over \$1.75M in federal funding has been awarded for this improvement project. Work in the area is anticipated to begin late this year.

It is going to be a busy construction season. While these projects are underway, we will be updating our asset management plan, identifying future infrastructure and roadway improvements and looking at funding sources.

A Message from Public Works

Branch pick-up will begin April 1, weather pending. The entire Town's branches will be picked up typically within the first 10 business days of each month. To ensure that branches are picked up, please have them ready by 7:00 am, the first business day of each month through December 1.

The leaf-vac will also make its way around town, once at the beginning of April and again at the end of April for a quick clean up through town. The vac will not be back out until October however, residents are welcome to bring leaves and branches to Public Works during business hours: Monday - Friday 7:00 am-3:00 pm.

Rain Barrel & Composter Ordering

Did you know that lawn and garden watering make up almost 40% of water usage during the summer months? A rain barrel collects water and stores it for when you need it most! Saving water not only helps protect the environment, it saves you money and energy. Diverting water from storm drains also decreases the impact of runoff to streams. Therefore, a rain barrel is an easy way for you to have a consistent supply of clean, fresh water for outdoor use, free. The Town of Cedar Lake will work with UpCycle Products to host a rain barrel event for Earth Day! You can order through the Town's website, www.cedarlakein.org, which will allow you to pre-order your rain barrel for this spring! Rain barrels come in black, grey, blue, and terra cotta. Pre-ordered rain barrels will be available for pick up on Friday, April 20 from 2 to 5 pm at the Cedar Lake Town Hall, 7408 Constitution Avenue.
