Each year millions of dollars in property damage, personal injuries and even loss of life occur because of careless digging, boring and blasting when underground facilities were not located prior to excavating. With each passing year, more and more lines are being installed and the problems increase for everyone involved.

- 1. Call 811, 1-800-382-5544
- 2. Wait for member facility owners/operators to mark the proposed excavation site.
- 3. Respect the marks. There is a 2 foot hand dig zone on either side of the marked buried facility that extreme care must be taken, and only hand or vacuum excavation is allowed in this zone.
- 4. Dig with care.
