Board of Zoning Appeals

At the Board of Zoning Appeals meeting on July 12, 2018 they were presented for a third time with a proposition for a Special Use Variance. This Special Use Variance is to operate a charitable haunted attraction at 12615 Wicker Avenue. After much discussion at three different BZA meetings, the Board sent a favorable recommendation to the Town Council per the request. The Town Council then heard the request at the July 17, 2018 meeting. The

favorable recommendation per the request was granted. The primary focus of this attraction is for a charitable cause to bring "Don't Be a Monster", a non-bullying campaign to local schools, stated one of the Petitioners.
