Therefore, a rain barrel is an easy way for you to have a consistent supply of

clean, fresh water for outdoor use, free. The Town of Cedar Lake will work with UpCycle Products to host a rain barrel event for Earth Day! Prices start from \$54.00 for a 55 gallon barrel and range with the type of product and come in a variety of colors. **Pre-ordered rain barrels will be available for pick up on Earth Day - Monday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> from 2 to 5 pm at the Cedar Lake Town Hall, 7408 Constitution Avenue. Lake County Solid Waste Management District's *Recycle Right* campaign is geared towards educating Northwest Indiana's communities about proper household recycling at LCSW's Recycle Centers. These are acceptable materials:

**Plastics:** #s 1-5, 7 (no plastic bags)

**Glass:** glass bottles, glass jars

**Paper:** newspapers, magazines, junk mail, paper (no shredded paper), milk or juice cartons, flattened cardboard

**Metal:** food or beverage cans

## PUBLIC WORKS - LEAF AND BRANCH PICK UP

During the first and last business weeks of April (April 1<sup>st</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> and April 22<sup>nd</sup> - 26<sup>th</sup>) Public Works will pick up leaves. Public Works does not require a phone call or an address; just have your leaves out by the road and follow our usual leaf pickup guidelines on the Town website - [cedarlakein.org](http://cedarlakein.org) - under "Departments," "Public Works," and "Leaf Pickup."

We will also start the Town's branch pickups on the first business day of April, Monday April 1<sup>st</sup>. It will take Public Works approximately 5-10 business days each month now through November to make our way around the Town once until the following month. Please follow the branch

pickup guidelines on the Town website under "Departments," "Public Works," and "Branch Pickup."
