CEDAR LAKE ECO-RESTORATION MOVING FORWARD

Cedar Lake Town Council welcomed US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Chicago District Commander Col. Aaron Reisinger and Project Manager Imad Samara at the April 2, 2019 Town Council Meeting. USACE has been working with the Town since



2003 to develop a plan for the eco-restoration of Cedar Lake. The feasibility study was submitted and approved by Congress in January. USACE and Cedar

could be started in 2021. Reisinger visited Cedar Lake last year and was able to go out onto the lake to see what was necessary for the project. Reisinger stated, "My team and I are committed to seeing this through." Council Members expressed gratitude and

thanks to many involved including engineers Kay Whitlock and Don Oliphant, Bob Gross, Diane Jostes, Senator Richard Niemeyer, and Representative Mike

Aylesworth, as well as those initiating the project and fundraising that have passed away. Bob Gross noted many donated to the project who will never see it come to fruition as they have passed away, but noted, "This is a big day for Cedar Lake. It's probably one of the largest things that ever happened in this community."



Lake's next step is a detailed design to move the project forward. USACE and Cedar Lake are reviewing and discussing a design agreement. Reisinger stated, "The big goal is to put ourselves into competitive position for federal funding in 2020." If funding were granted in 2020, the project

TOWN-WIDE SPRING CLEANING

This month, between May 7th and May 9th, in 8 locations around Town, Public Works will have dumpsters dropped off and available for residents to utilize. Dumpsters will be available for 2 weeks, including 2 weekends. The dumpsters will be for items such as unwanted furniture, mattresses, wood, or carpeting; no tires, stony materials (rocks, bricks, or concrete) or hazardous materials are allowed. Dumpster removal will be from May 20th through May 22nd. Please call Public Works with any questions at 219-374-7478.

- On lot across from Holy Name Church

Public Works will also be trimming trees and foliage in Winding Creek 1 & 2 in parkways where the foliage extends too far into the roadways. This will be taking place throughout the month.
