FIREWORKS TOWN ORDINANCE (102.03)

Consumer Fireworks (previously known as Class C) can only be used on property owned by a person or with permission and by someone over the age of 18 years unless with parent during June 29 – July 9 from 5 pm to 2 hours after sunset (11 pm) and July 4th from 10 am to midnight. CENSUS

Did you know during the 2010 census, the total population of Cedar Lake was noted at 11,560? The estimated population of Indiana as of July 1, 2018 was 6,691,878. 23.6% of that 6 million population was under the age of 18 and 15.4% was over 65 years of age.
