



SCHOOL BUS SAFETY


The following are tips from the Cedar Lake Police to ensure safety throughout the school year:

Stopping on Various Types of Roadways


- Two-Lane Roadways: If a school bus stops on a two lane road and the red flashing lights are activated and the stop arm is extended, all motorists MUST stop.
- Multi-Lane Roads with No Barrier Between Lanes: When a school bus stops on a multi-lane roadway without a barrier and the red flashing lights are activated and the stop arm is extended, all motorists MUST stop.
- Multi-Lane Roadway with Grassy &/or Concrete Barrier: When a school bus stops and the red flashing lights are activated and the stop arm is extended, only vehicles behind the bus MUST stop. Vehicles that are approaching from the opposite side are NOT required to stop.







MULTI-LANE PAVED ACROSS: Vehicles traveling in both directions MUST stop.



Vehicles behind bus MUST stop.

Vehicles traveling in the opposite

direction proceed with caution.

BUS INSPECTION INFORMATION

Indiana State Law requires that state police inspect all buses annually and buses at least 12 years old semiannually for safety. You can easily check the safety of your child's school buses at:
