REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

At the October 21, 2019 meeting, the Redevelopment Commission approved the creation of a façade grant improvement program, which set aside \$100,000 towards this program for upcoming year. Redevelopment Commission (RDC) President Nathan Vis presented information on the new façade grant improvement program at the Cedar Lake Chamber of Commerce luncheon on November 14, 2019. Vis indicated Cedar Lake has some of the highest increase in property values across Lake County. He gave background information on the purpose of RDC including the desire to revitalize commercial corridors. The corridor extends from the Town Hall grounds out to Lake Shore Drive up and around the lake to 133rd along with up/down Hwy 41.

The RDC has been working on a variety of projects throughout Town one being the development of a façade grant improvement program. The program is designed to promote continued use and maintenance of commercial and mixed use buildings in the Town's commercial corridors. It is intended to aid and assist property owners and commercial tenants in rehabilitation and restoration of the visible exterior, landscaping and pedestrian entrances/exterior components of buildings. Applicants may receive up to 50% reimbursement for improvements valued at minimum \$7500 with a 5 year commitment to maintain the improvements made.

Applications will be reviewed on a first come/first serve basis by the RDC. For more information on requirements.

WINTER SAFETY INFORMATION



INDOT, Cedar Lake Police & Fire Department and Cedar Lake Public Works want you and your family to stay safe on the roads this winter. By following these tips and advice, you'll be ready for winter driving:

 Before leaving home, find out about the driving conditions. Ice and Snow, Take it Slow...or just don't go.

- Remove any snow on your vehicle's windows, lights, brake lights and signals. Make sure you can see and be seen.
- Remember to drive well below the posted speed limit.
 Take it slow when approaching intersections, off-ramps, bridges or shady areas all are hot spots for black ice.
- Brake early, brake slowly, brake correctly and never slam on the brakes. If you have anti-lock brakes, press the pedal down firmly and hold it. If you don't have anti-lock brakes, gently pump the pedal. Give yourself plenty of room to stop.
- When driving on ice and snow, do not use cruise control and avoid abrupt steering maneuvers.

SNOW PLOW SAFETY

- The plows are wide and can cross the centerline or shoulder. Don't tailgate and try not to pass. If you must pass, take extreme caution and beware of the snow cloud.
- Snowplows travel below the posted speed limit. Be patient. Allow plenty of time to slow down.
- A snowplow operator's field of vision is restricted. You
 may see them, but they don't always see you. Keep
 your distance and watch for sudden stops or turns.
