Aquatic Vegetation: No submersed aquatic vegetation was collected; several spots along the western shore

had emergent plant beds.

Comments: A total of 3,369 fish were collected during this survey, but 86% of fish were undesirable White Perch. Channel Catfish were the most abundant, angler desirable species and 45% of catfish were 11 to 16 inches an additional 20% were over 20 inches. Hybrid Striped Bass are annually stocked by the Division of Fish & Wildlife several were collected but a 2020 targeted survey is more representative of their size and abundance. While White and Black Crappie combined have low abundance their size up to 13.5 inches attracts anglers. Nine large Walleyes, which are not stocked by the DFW, were collected up to 24.2 inches. After dredging efforts are completed follow-up fish surveys should be conducted to evaluate the fish community.




Figure 1. White Perch length frequency, 64% of fish collected were between 6 and 8 inches.




Figure 2. Bluegill length frequency.




Figure 3. Bluegill average length at age compared to the 25th and 75th growth percentiles. Any age between the 25th and 75th percentiles is considered average growth while any above or below them is considered great or poor growth.




Figure 4. Channel Catfish length frequency.




Figure 5. Channel Catfish average length at age.
